2.



Receive an allocation of hours from MOE

3.

### The simple three step process explained:

**Check out the deadline dates for applications in your region (note if there are old dates published, this means the next round hasn't been announced yet).**



## Identify your school's needs and prepare your proposal related to the national PLD priorities.

- It is best if we [jump on a call to discuss](#) this with you as early as possible so we can create a draft proposal for submission that meets the expectations of the Ministry.
- There are guides available to support you through the process here. There is also a document that has the questions you need to provide information around when you submit your proposal on this same page. This allows you to prepare it all before you begin the online process. (make a copy and use it to draft your application.)
- The panel is looking to hear your story. They want to know how your PLD would impact not just your teachers but your students also.

### Also consider:

- Who have you consulted when gathering your data?
- Have you included community voice?
- How will you measure the impact of the PLD?

## Submit your proposal using the online portal

We will have the draft proposal finalised so it will be easy to transfer to the MOE system



Once you have your application approved, we will meet with you to plan out your PD plan.
